Student Contract

2024 – 2025 Academic Year

Arrival & Departure: Students are expected to assist with set-up and clean-up. Students attending an 8:30 class need to arrive no later than 8:20 to ensure classes start on time.

Remaining at CCT: Students are expected to remain at Cornerstone through their last class. Students may not leave the premises with other students during the day.

Food & Beverage: All meals must be consumed in an indoor or outside designated area. Food and drink are not permitted in the classrooms except for class-related events or during times designated by instructors. Students must clean up their lunch area including the table and floor. If needed, students will vacuum or sweep. Students are not permitted to use kitchen appliances nor store in or remove items from the kitchen pantry, freezer, or refrigerator. Colored drinks may not be consumed in any carpeted area.

Clothing: From shoulders to mid-thigh, neither students' bodies nor underwear shall be visible. Sleeveless tops are permitted as long as the top of the shoulder is mostly covered. Girls: no tight tops, see-through tops, low-cut tops, bare midriffs, nor cleavage showing. Boys: no falling-down pants, earrings, nail polish, or make-up. Tight, Spandex-type athletic pants/leggings may only be worn with a long top that covers all private areas. Shorts must be fingertip length and may not be the tight, Spandex-type. No hats indoors with the exception of event costumes permitted at the discretion of the tutors and administrators. Hair dyes of unnatural color are strongly discouraged and may be restricted based on the display. Clothing with derogatory or negative messages is not permitted. Students inappropriately dressed will be asked by the service parent or an instructor to phone home and request a change of clothing.

Study Halls: Students participating in study halls are expected to bring work. During the first 75 minutes of each session a strict quiet time will be enforced. During the remaining 15 minutes, students may talk and play games. Electronic devices such as iPods, cell phones, tablets, etc. are to be used for study purposes only and must not be heard by others.

Building Usage: Please remember we are guests of Cornerstone and need to respect the building. Trash should be disposed of properly. Rooms that are not designated for CCT are not to be used.

Class Assignments: Need to be turned in on the assigned date. If you are struggling or have a question, call, or email your instructor. They are available and want to help you.

Course Grades: You are responsible for keeping track of your grades.

Behavior: Students are expected to treat others in a way that honors Jesus Christ. CCT will appropriately discipline behaviors that are disrespectful or questionable. Serious and/or dangerous behaviors that may result in immediate expulsion include **stealing, assault, threat of injury, fighting, or engaging in inappropriate sexual behavior or conversations.**
